Welcome to our Spring community newsletter.

Spring always brings out the best in Bingara Gorge. As the weather warms up, our estate is starting to bloom with an array of seasonal flowers, new growth, gardening activities and outdoor recreational pursuits.

Construction and civil works have continued with Fairways North 8B – E nearing completion and registration on track for September. Engineering works are continuing in Stages 9A – C and we expect to finish civil works in November, followed by registration in January 2024.

The main entry and exit points into Bingara Gorge via the Pembroke/Picton Road intersection upgrade are now complete and have greatly improved road safety for residents.

Pleasingly, we can confirm a development application for the golf bridge has been submitted and when completed, will permit 18 holes of golf to be played. As this submission progresses through the approval process, more positive updates will be provided to our community.

Parks continue to be an important focus in our world-class community with the delivery of new high-quality recreational amenities, enabling

residents to live an active outdoor lifestyle. In welcome news, we recently received development approval for Fairways North Park and lodged a development application for Homestead Park.

Shaded spaces and turfed areas will provide a range of options to enjoy exercise, relaxation or gatherings with family and friends. The park embraces and preserves

select elegant native gum trees and ancient sandstone outcrops as well as emphasises the amphitheatre shaped landform to engage with the beautiful waterbody.

Development approval has been obtained for Fairways North Park with work anticipated to start later this year and completion scheduled for early 2024.

Two distinctive golf bridges

Exciting news! The development application for Bingara Gorge's Golf Course bridges has been submitted. These distinctive double tower cable bridges once finished, will not only enable the opening of all 18 holes of the Bingara Gorge Golf Course but will also provide essential pedestrian access across the gorge, connecting all precincts to the community facilities.

Crossing Stringybark Creek, these bridges will be a length of 107m and an elevation of 16.95m. Pending council and authority's timing, we anticipate that the construction of these bridges will be completed in approximately 18 months.

New recreational zone – Homestead Park

Our Homestead parklands are set to become another main recreational zone for Bingara Gorge residents with tennis courts, multi-use courts for basketball and handball/futsal, interactive shaded playground and extensive open space for fun activities all year round. There's also a toilet facility and outdoor covered BBQs too.

Child/adult outdoor gym equipment, covered tennis courts with shelter, all weather concrete path loops for

running, scooter riding and boot camp circuits and a large informal turfed kick about area with views to the hardcourt precinct and golf course fairways are some of the key elements residents can expect to use.

A generous sandstone log wall also provides an informal amphitheatre with beautiful views over the extensive grass areas supported by seating for gatherings and community events. We are awaiting council approval.
