Our highly anticipated Bingara Gorge Bike Park has received approval with construction to commence mid-year. In more positive community facilities news, Homestead Park is now approved with work soon to commence.



Retail News at Bingara Gorge

To support our growing community and increasing retail demand, the retail neighbourhood centre site at 30 Pembroke Road was sold to Coles. Council approved a development application for a full-line supermarket, complementary specialty stores, convenient car parking and click and collect services.

We have a shared vision with Coles to deliver a high-quality retail asset for the Bingara Gorge community. The addition of Coles will provide convenient access to groceries. More than 100 jobs will be created during construction and over 100 permanent positions.

Interactive Bike Park

Delivering very exciting news - Bingara Gorge's Bike Park has received approval and is set to provide many hours of exhilarating fun for all ages and abilities.

The concept plan for the trail loop is approximately two kilometres and located on the Fairways North side of the estate within a bushland setting.

Riders will be able to access the interactive bike park from Reginald Circuit and Cuttriss Crescent. An asphalt-surfaced pump track and skills park will feature alongside the trail loop, providing another level of enjoyment for residents in the great outdoors.

The trail will be an easy flow style with optional alignments for different abilities to enable progression for people looking to expand their skills as well as challenging obstacles for more experienced riders. Bike trail infrastructure is an ideal inclusion in any masterplanned community as it provides another outdoor recreational amenity for residents to use.

Bingara Gorge's Bike Park is meticulously designed to cater for all family members and their various skill levels. The benefits of exercising outdoors for physical, mental and social reasons are well documented. Mountain biking provides an excellent outlet to release natural endorphins and improve both mind and body health.


The home backs onto the golf course providing stunning views of the lake surrounded by the picturesque landscape, all captured from the first-floor balcony.
