The architectural and external finishes boast traditional coastal Hamptons style architecture featuring symmetry with a pitched roof, gables and window grids. In addition to the render and weatherboard cladding, the exposed rafter

tails and dressed timber detailing paired with the feature dry stack stone piers at the entrance, all create a heavily detailed façade.

Large windows, white painted walls and an open floor plan, help further accentuate natural light and create bright spaces.

"Crisp white and soft, muted colours such as shades of white and warm greys together with layered materials and texture, supported by natural materials like timber, stone, shaker profile cabinetry, wallpaper, VJ panelling and wainscoting throughout creates a warm and inviting ambience," added Chad.

"To create a casual and comfortable feel, the home will be styled with plush furniture and upholstery in neutral tones, accented with pastel colours. From the intricate detailing of the wainscoting throughout, to the inclusion of Miele kitchen appliances, this home truly is a showpiece."
